- Current First Aid, Anaphylaxis and Asthma certification or willing to obtain
- Availability in line with our operational hours
 - **Before School Care:** Monday to Friday between the hours of 6:30am - 9:00am
 - **After School Care:** Monday to Friday between the hours of 2:30pm - 6:00pm (applicants will only be successful if they are available to work a minimum of three (3) afternoons per week)
 - **Vacation Care:** Monday to Friday between the hours of 6:30am - 6:00pm
