### Principal's Update

Report to be tabled on the night

- School is operating as normal now, have had small spikes in children and staff being away but nothing major.
- Covid protocols unchanged - parents still allowed on site, volunteers must still be double vaccinated.
- Year 5 camp at Mudjimba Wednesday to Friday this week.
- Zoom meetings can be offered again, IT constraint has been resolved. Perhaps every second meeting and/or when major events are coming up.
- 2022 Junior School P&C budget request total \$23,026:
  - Art show \$5,500
  - Music resources \$4,500
  - Year 5 Graduation (incl Taylor Range) \$3,500
  - Music new instrument purchases \$9,526
- P&C contribution to School operations request \$10,000 (to be funded directly by KGSC P&C):
  - Science Resources
  - Drone Technology
  - IT support (feeding into Technology subject)
  - Keyboards for iPads
- What types of things does the school fund that is outside/above standard school funding?
  - Italian commences in Grade 2 (vs Ed QLD grade 5)
  - Non-contact time
  - Visual Art time (outside the minimum Art requirement)

- Guidance Officer time 2 days per week
- Speech Language 3 days per week
- More time for teachers for Health program (taught half by school teachers)
- Learning Assistance support (reading/writing/teacher aid time)
- EALD cohort greatly reduced in previous years due to Covid restrictions and consequent impact on staffing.
- Census date was later this year (moved to day 32 from day 8)
- Explicit Improvement Area for 2022 is the continued rollout of the national curriculum.
- Differentiation within the school – moving away from the verification process, to National Consistent Collection of Data (flowing out of Disability Discrimination Act).
- Development of teaching and assessment programs (only two programs have been externally sourced, rest are internally developed).
- Volunteers – new Pick Up Zone volunteers this year, parent behaviour has improved this year.
